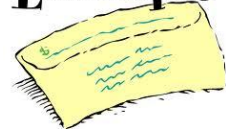

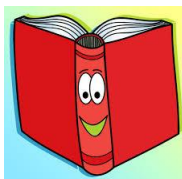

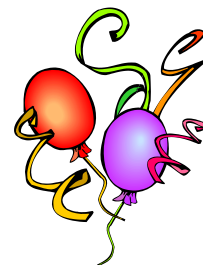
SENIORS SPIRITUALITY & REFLECTION

we are ourselves.

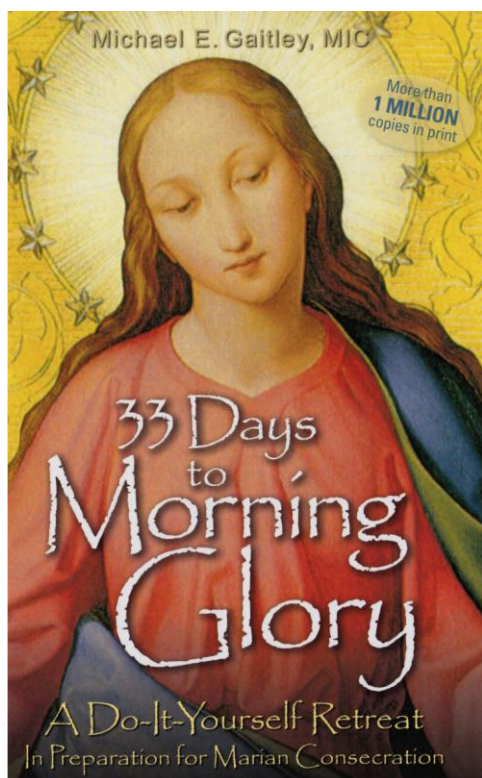

Consecration to Jesus Through Mary
