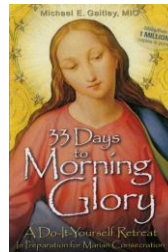

It is not a difficult process and any priest can inform you of the process. If interested, please call Fr. David or Fr. Marino for more information.

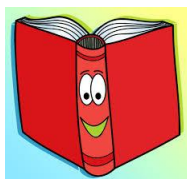
PILGRIMAGE

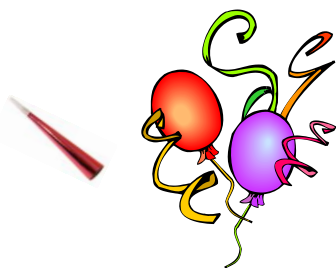
