YEAR OF CONSECRATED LIFE POSTER CONTEST

Pope Francis declared this year the "Year of Consecrated Life," encouraging a focus on those particular vocations for men and women. In response, the St. Luke's Vocation Committee is hosting a "Year of Consecrated Life Poster Contest" for youth. Students are encouraged to depict a saint who lived as a consecrated religious.

The posters may include: 1) What the saint did in his/her consecrated life, 2) How he/she adored or glorified God, 3) A key message from the life of the saint, 4) How we can live out the message of the saint or model our lives on his/her story.

There will be three age categories: Primary – Grade 3, Grade 4-6, and Grade 7-9. One winner will be selected from each category and each winner will receive a family pass to One Rock 2015.

TO BUILD A CHAPEL

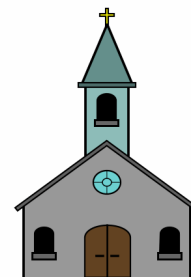
