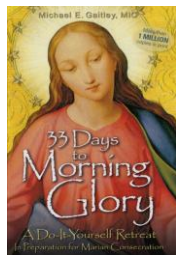

March 15: Lent IV

The image of the crucifix is itself a prayer for many Catholics. What do you see when you look at this image of Christ? Are you baffled and confused? Are you grateful for His mercy? Do you feel helpless and saddened? Are you moved or do you stare in disbelief? We are encouraged to lift up our eyes and see the One, who has created all things. As you ponder the meaning of the Cross, above all consider this: Christ chooses to be bound here, immovable. He chooses to suffer through the Cross that we might look at Him and be healed.

Action: Spend time in quiet in front of a cross or crucifix. Observe how this contemplation affects you.
