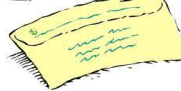

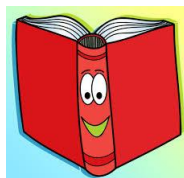

We are there to meet their spiritual needs, being respectful of their own religious beliefs and practice.

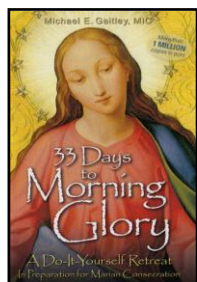
Our ministry involves all Christians, priests, religious and laity joined in prayer,

We represent the love, prayers and support of St. Luke's Church for one of the members who is ill and not able to come to the community celebration. We are therefore linking St. Luke's Parish and our parishioner who is ill. We are saying that on behalf of the parish community that we care and we are sharing in this setback. The ministry team takes Communion to those who are sick, and they contact the pastor if the person requests Reconciliation or the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick.
