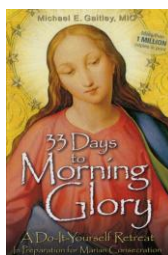

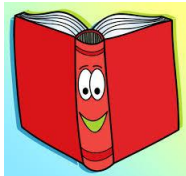

"POSTER CONTEST"**

*Pope Francis* declared this year the "Year of Consecrated Life," encouraging a focus on those particular vocations for men and women. In response, the St. Luke's Vocation Committee is hosting a "Year of Consecrated Life Poster Contest" for youth. Students are encouraged to depict a saint who lived as a consecrated religious.

**The posters may include:** 1) What the saint did in his/her consecrated life, 2) How he/she adored or glorified God, 3) A key message from the life of the saint, 4) How we can live out the message of the saint or model our lives on his/her story.

### FEBRUARY 15: 6<sup>TH</sup> SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Catholics celebrate the sacrament of Reconciliation because we recognise that sometimes we fail to do as we ought and because we believe in God's mercy and forgiveness. Has it been a while since you received the sacrament of Reconciliation? Are you unsure of what to do? Maybe you are embarrassed, afraid, or ashamed? Know that the sacrament is completely confidential and the decision to come is cause for rejoicing. The priest can help you begin and you can trust the Holy Spirit to take over from there. Even if you don't know how you can change your life, showing up makes you open to the grace that the sacrament brings. The Diocese of Calgary invites you to re-discover the meaning of the sacrament of Reconciliation in your life.

**Action:** If you are afraid to go to Reconciliation, speak about your reservations with a priest or someone you know who does participate in the sacrament.
