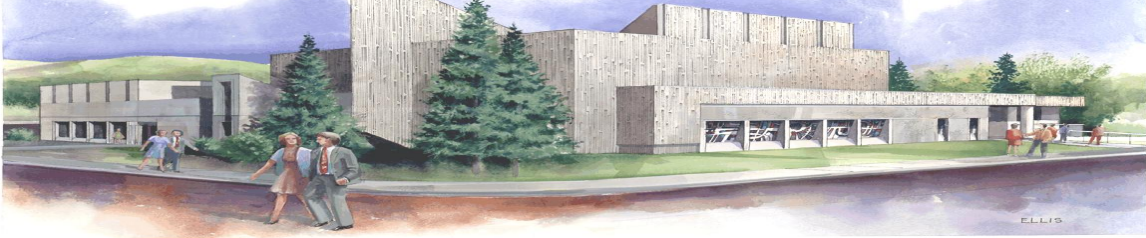

BUILDING A NEW CULTURE:

Many Catholics today are rightly concerned about the state of our natural environment. In order to assist them, the Episcopal Commission for Justice and Peace of the Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops (CCCCB) is offering a modest outline of 8 central themes found in recent Church teaching on the environment.

These reflect on how a Catholic approach to economic questions, social justice, and environmental questions are necessarily viewed in relation to each other. It is hoped that these themes will serve as a guide to discussion, reflection, and decision-making on the very real environmental problems we face today.

SECOND CENTRAL THEME:

Creation has an Intrinsic Order

The created universe is the fruit of the love of God, which has produced human beings in his image who can recognize the intelligent ordering of creation. Because of their privileged position in creation, human beings must recognize their responsibility to be guardians of this creation, and to ensure the proper balance of the ecosystems they depend on.
