#### SOCIAL JUSTICE

"IWIN - I'm Worth It Now" held a backpack assembly day in November. CWL Members from St. Luke's, Holy Spirit, St. Michael's and others assembled 90 backpacks.

Agencies that received these were: Calgary (RESET Society of Calgary), Edmonton (CEASE - Centre to End All Sexual Exploitation), Saskatoon (Hope Restored Canada), and Winnipeg (Dignity House).

IWIN is now a registered charity. All donations \$25 or more receive a tax receipt.

Did you know that 72% of reported human trafficking victims in Canada are under 25 years of age,

and 93% of reported victims are Canadians being trafficked domestically?

Did you know most victims don't generally know they are being trafficked? The grooming is done subtly and takes place over time. Then it seems like it is too late to get out.

#### **SERVICE**


Volunteers will be needed for the CWL Service Weekend.
