St. Luke's Parish Lectors

The role of a fector

Lectors proclaim God's word. In proclaiming the Scriptures, the lector becomes the voice through which the Spirit speaks in the worshipping assembly. To do this faithfully, the lector must allow the Scriptures to become immersed deeply in his/her life very and consciousness.

At each of our five Eucharistic Celebrations three lectors are assigned, with one beginning with the announcements and the Prayers of the Faithful, one will proclaim the First Reading and one the Second reading.

An orientation session is held each fall for all lectors who have chosen that ministry for the coming year. The session provides instructions on the required routines and processes and allows an opportunity for lectors to practice their delivery at the microphone.

A schedule is prepared covering a three month period and delivered quarterly to all lectors. You may expect to be required to serve at least twice during each schedule. On receipt of the schedule, it is then your responsibility to ensure you are available and attend the required Mass time. If this does not fit with your schedule you may contact another lector to obtain a replacement.
