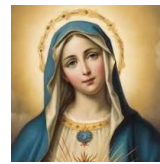

Father Paul's Column



FIRST THREE QUESTIONS THAT GOD ASKED ADAM AND EVE

GEN 3:9 - The LORD God then called to the man and asked him, "**Where are you?**"

Did you ever experience in your life God asking you the same question? **WHERE ARE YOU?** Yes, **whenever we sin** God asks us this question. **If we do not pray**, God asks us this question. **If we are not with him**, God asks us this question.

GEN 3:11 - Then he asked, "**Who told you that you were naked?** You have eaten, then, from the tree of which I had forbidden you to eat!"

Adam was ashamed that he was naked only after he committed a sin. **Am I ashamed of my sins? Do I feel ok or comfortable committing certain sins** in my life? **How often do we not feel bad** committing certain sins in our lives?

GEN 3:13 - The LORD God then asked the woman, "**Why did you do such a thing?**" The woman answered, "The serpent tricked me into it, so I ate it."

Are we blaming others for our faults and sins? Whenever we commit a sin, God will ask the same question to us - **Why did you do such a thing?** How often will God ask this question to us.
